

\*\* Please make sure to call your child out of school! Please refer to the student handbook for more information!


## Student Dress Code

# Morning Arrival

## Afternoon Dismissal

\*At 3:15, an announcement will be made to dismiss all after-care and out-of district students.

\*At 3:20, an announcement will be made to dismiss all walker and carline students.

\* First floor carline/walking students will meet Mrs. Coughlin by the elevator and then, as a group, they will exit the building through the front door together. Bus Dismissal

\*At 3:21, an announcement will be made to dismiss all first floor bus students.

Teachers will walk their class out of the building and students will walk to their busses on their own.

### Lunch Information

\*Students must pack a lunch every day. We encourage reusable containers/water bottles to reduce waste in our school.

\*All snacks should be packed separately with your child's name on it to avoid confusion!

\*All snacks should be dry and nut free!

## Homework Policy

#### Homework in 1st Grade:

- Starts in October (Monthly homework log/Class news)
- Reading-10 minutes each night-book, read aloud, RAZ kids
  - Practice sight words-5 minutes each night
    Math Homework-One worksheet (double-sided)each week
    que on Friday (can be turned in earlier)
- HW Log must be signed on a weekly basis and collected at the end of every month!

# Grading Policy

#### Report Card Grading Criteria:

- 4: Consistently produces work/behavior of high quality and applies learned skills independently
- 3: Frequently produces quality work/behavior and applies learned skills independently
- 2: Produces work/behavior and applies learned skills, sometimes requiring support
- 1: Produces work/behavior with frequent need for reteaching/redirecting

<u>Lashin Loot</u>-Children can earn Lashin Loot by following directions, being a role model, helping others, etc. Each child has their own banks!

Star Student-A child is picked on a weekly basis who is doing a stand out job! They will get their picture and a poster hung in the hallway! They also get an award and a free choice reading seat!

Maxwell-Each week a student gets to take home Maxwell for the weekend and write about their adventures with him! We will share their writing on Monday!!

Marble Jar-When filled, class gets a special reward (pajama day, etc.)

<u>Trailblazers-</u> School wide program to promote positive behavior in school! Students are given a certificate of achievement

#### Color Clip Chart-

Green: Great day! Right on track!

Orange: Warning! Make smarter choices!

Red: Teacher Decision based on poor choice (email/call home, etc)

\*\*\*\*Students can move up and down all day!

- Conduct Referrals-Clearly communicate behavior with parents and to document student's inappropriate behavior.
- All students K-8 can be issued a conduct referral by any staff member in the building.
- Please remember, conduct referrals are a communication tool only.
- You will be contacted via phone or email about the incident.
- They must be signed and returned to the teacher the next day
- The dean of students will receive a copy of the conduct referral
